If anyone has any raffle tickets, please return to NYSAPLS as soon as possible. Mona will be retiring on January 1, a replacement has been found. The NYSAPLS Officers will be the same as last year. There have been problems getting on the NYSAPLS Website. They are working on the problem. There is a proposed amendment to the Education Law in relation to the authenticity of documents that are submitted by applicants. The Code of Practice may be changed to provide a penalty for rubber-stamping maps.
