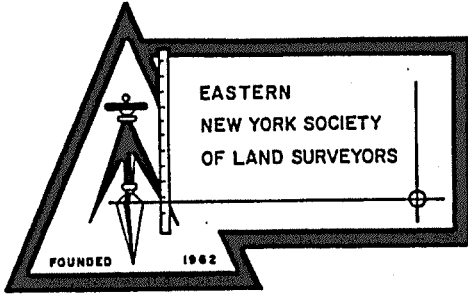

Ethical and Business Practices: Ellen reported that there has been an increase in the number of maps that are being modified and submitted to boards by other design professionals. Please look out for problem situations in your area of practice.

- **Continuing Education:** Jody Lounsbury and Chuck Lent are continuing their work on a program about railroad surveys. There will be a seminar in Rochester on May 4 entitled "Integrating GPS & Terrestrial Survey Data Via the Global Spatial Data Model (GSDM)". A seminar on least squares adjustments is being planned to be held in Binghamton area; the date has not been set.
