MINUTES

EASTERN NEW YORK SOCIETY OF LAND SURVEYORS BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING March 10, 2022

Virtual Meeting by phone and PC
Due to COVID-19 Pandemic gathering restrictions

President Strom called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Dwayne Cooper

• The February 2022 meeting minutes were presented to and reviewed by the BOD. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Jim Vianna, seconded by Kaleb Winters. A vote was held, and the motion passed.

- A discussion was held on NYSDOT's new policy of not providing right of way information. Kaleb noted that NYSDOT has begun to fill vacancies. It is unclear if filling vacancies will change the current policy.
- Jim, Brie and Kaleb said that they will set up a time to meet and sign new cards. Jim stated that he has all the paperwork gathered up.

New Business:

- A discussion was held on Certified Floodplain Surveyors for New York State. Kaleb stated that he felt the
 email was intended to give the topic exposure and to try and gain traction. The consensus was to have Brie
 and Jason bring it up to Patty Brooks at the next NYSAPLS BOD meeting.
- A discussion was held on whether or not to have an in person BOD meeting in April. It was decided to hold an
 in person meeting with the option of those not able or comfortable meeting in person to join virtually. Jim said

- Brie gave a summary of a package of documents that she and the ethics committee received. After a
 discussion it was decided that there is no ethics violation, the situation is just a property line dispute. Brie said
 that she would follow up with the person that sent the information.
- March 20-26 is National Surveyors Week. Kaleb noted that several employees at DEC were going to be involved in a media campaign to promote it.
- Jim asked if NYSAPLS has taken a position on the U.S. Survey Foot being dropped in favor of International Foot. Brie stated that she didn't recall hearing anything about it at last NYSAPLS BOD meeting. Kaleb shared a link that stated the U.S. Survey Foot will not be used after December 31st.
