EASTERN NEW YORK SOCIETY OF LAND SURVEYORS BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING May 19, 2022

Hybrid Meeting
The Mill, Round Lake, NY and virtual

President Strom called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m.

Secretary's Report: Dwayne Cooper

• The April meeting minutes were presented to the BOD by President Meisler and reviewed by the BOD. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Kaleb Winters, seconded by Larry O'Connor. A vote was held, and the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Jim Vianna

- Jim reported to the BOD on the LPL account balance and the Bank account balance.
- A motion for ENYSLS to purchase more checks was made by Randy Paquin, seconded by Larry O'Connor. A
 vote was held, and the motion passed.
- Jim reported that the new Post Office Box fee would be \$198 annually up from \$166.

President's Report: Brie Meisler

- Brie reported that she has changed her last name from Strom to Meisler.
- Brie submitted receipts for reimbursement for lodging while attending the Strategic Planning Conference. The reimbursement had already been voted on and approved by the BOD. Brie reported that the conference was well run and in her opinion was a success. Some of the topics discussed included: Pathways to Surveying, moving forward with Minimum Technical Standards, Legislative Initiatives, Health of the Regionals and Member Engagement, Education and other programming for members, Access to Public Records and the Economic well-being of surveyors.
- Brie reported on the NYSAPLS Board meeting
 - o The budget was passed, and it included the first wage increase for NYSAPLS staff in four years. Heather has been with NYSAPLS nine years and now has a new title, Director of Operations.
 - o The 2023 Conference is being planned for in-person.

- The Ad-Hoc DOT relations committee has met twice. The charge of the committee is to encourage lines of communication with DOT, and to assist DOT with access to acquisition mapping. They will likely expand the charge of this committee to encompass all public records. Legal counsel has been brought in to help with contacts with the higher ranks of the agency
- Education committee hosted several successful in-person workshops. Conference planned for in-person but will investigate hybrid model.
- Working with State Board about interpretation of new education requirements. Language is inconsistent in various places on the website.
- A new secretary, who is a PE, has been appointed to SBELSG
- o The MTS committee is still awaiting feedback from State Board
- o PR committee is currently focusing their social media campaign on Survey Innovation
- Strategic Planning session had 38 attendees, 16 of which were new. 5 regionals were not represented. Jim adds that CTS was a big point of discussion.
- o YP committee are continuing their webcasts, which continue to be available on YouTube.
- o The Fort Drum career fair was a success. It would have been helpful if it had been more fully staffed.
