

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING Fabruary March 12, 1969

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors was called to order by President Hartnett at 7:30 p.m. on March 12, 1969, at the office of Gilbert, Selee and Carpenter, Albany, New York. Present were Directors Hartnett, McCormack, Schraa, Boutelle, Czaban and Carpenter.

Joseph A. Bruno and Frank Breeman of Pension and Investment Associates of America, Inc., explained a split-funded pension plan for the general membership. This plan would involve investing in both mutual funds and life insurance. It was decided by the Board of Directors that this particular plan had no advantages for an association and that probably each individual proprietor should investigate a pension plan of their own. Tom McCormack was asked to explain the entire pension plan picture to the general membership at the next meeting.
