#### Ammendment No. 3.

To By-Laws Article V, Section 1 add new sub-paragraph (i) Business Practices Committee: this committee shall:

1) Continually study current costs of labor, materials, equipment, etc. as they affect survey work.

2) Make periodically a survey of area personnel practices in order to better determine current operational costs.

#### Ammendment No. 4.

To. By-Laws Article V, Section 1 add new sub-paragraph (j) Technical Information Committee: this committee shall:

- 1) Through periodic reports inform the Society in regard to new laws or changes in laws, requirements, regulations, local ordinances, rules, map and report filings, as they pertain to the practice of Land Surveying.
- 2) Inform the Society of new techniques, equipment, etc.
