President's Report:

NYSAPLS Concerns

Headquarters Appeal - The total contribution to date is \$72,252. Eastern has pledged \$2,560. Eastern's Headquarters Fund Committee is soliciting donations. This site will be the new headquarters of NYSAPLS. Our previous lack of support for the headquarters may have resulted in loss of support by NYSAPLS toward our problem with Saratoga County map filing.

Eastern Concerns

Southern Tier Association of Land Surveyors requested our assistance in compiling data concerning the pursuit of the "N" Exemption for all land surveyors in New York State. They were interested in the number of people who want to acquire this license, possibly through exam and experience requirements. If the "N" Exemption is extended to all surveyors, engineers may want the "M" exemption extended.

Saratoga County Map Filing - On behalf of Eastern, Attny. Thomas Nolan has spoken with County Attorney A. Heggen regarding the problem and sent a formal letter to Mr. Heggen, who stated that he intends to review that portion of the law. We are now awaiting his response.

Eastern has received our copies of the 16MM film and a cassette of the film "A Matter of Degrees".
