Treasurer Cirillo submitted his report to the Board.

<u>President's Report:</u> NYSAPLS Concerns

September meeting was held in Rochester. A tour of the Civic Center, the site of the 1988 Annual Conference, was given. The Civic Center is connected to the Holiday Inn Hotel by a covered walk and has easy access.

Herb Ehrig and Leon Clarey from the State Board of Examiners attended the September NYSAPLS Board of Directors meeting. They are proposing legislation for changes in the 7208B law regarding the exemption of out-of-state surveyors being allowed to practice in New York State. After a lengthy discussion it was referred to our Legislative Committee for study. Discussion was also held on the "N" exemption without result. In addition discussion of proposed legislation re: maps recorded with deeds was held.

After a brief discussion it was agreed that one could make reference to maps, surveys or other information on the current map whether or not the information is recorded in the County Clerk's Office.

Executive Vice-President Davis inquired into the amount of dues required for reinstatement of members removed from membership rolls for non-payment of dues.

Vice-President Nettleton announced the receipt of 5 to 6 applications for membership to be voted upon at the next Board of Directors meeting.

Mike Davis reported the next regular membership will be held at the Paramount Lounge. The speaker will be John Scalzo of Region One, NYSDOT on the subject of EDM Data Collectors - Problems and Potential.

Harold Behrens stated under Business Practices that a Professional Engineer has been surveying in New Baltimore, Green County doing subdivision work.

Bill Nettleton reported the Handbook Committee is having the reprinting done and the new handbooks should be ready by January's annual meeting.

Old Business

After general discussion on the Saratoga County problem Bill Nettleton moved, seconded by Steve Dickson, that the President be authorized to continue to pursue activities in that area at an expense not to exceed \$1,000. After discussion the motion was passed unanimously.

Bill Nettleton said that the Journal ad copy was being printed and the application and fee are awaiting completion.

The next meeting will be held on Veterans Day, November 11, 1987, however the annual meeting will be moved to the third Wednesday, January 20, 1988 due to conflict with the 29th annual conference.

After general discussion on the subject of the recording of sketches with deeds, President Behrens appointed a committee to investigate the need and wording of any statement on the sketch concerning the identity and licensure status of the maker consisting of Bob Mac Farlane, Chris Momrow and Bill Schraa.

New Business

General discussion was held on the subject of the difficulty getting copies of maps from the files of either Region One or the NYSDOT at the campus.

Harold Behrens discussed the rule of Rensselaer County that even 5 acre lots must be reviewed by the County Health Department. Other counties have similar rules.

Neil Nucci lead a general discussion on monumentation prior to preliminary or final approval.

With no further business before the Board, President Behrens asked for a motion to adjorn, motion by Neil Nucci, seconded by Mike Davis: carried. The meeting was adjorned at 9:20 P.M.
