President's Report:

The State Board of Examiners is to form a committee to study our Position Paper on "N" exemption.

Town of Bergen, N.Y. is requiring surveyors to get permits to work along Town roads. This came about as a result of surveyors digging up pavement to uncover control points and property line monuments. Mona Glanzer is currently reviewing this and further information should be forthcoming.

Comments made on our Employee Evaluation Forms; may violate State and Federal statutes by requiring good physical health; too narrow of a definition for each classification.

Mona Glanzer should review prior to future printing.

State Board authorized \$4000 to have college students arrange and reprint "Motion and Second" during the summer.

Last annual conference details; \$114,000 taken in; 775 in attendance; \$86,000 expenses to date; \$20,000 of profit distributed as follows: \$7000 to Genesee Valley, \$8000 to NYSAPLS, \$5000 to scholarship.

Eastern Concerns:

Rensselaer County - 2 lot subdivision in Schodack may be a test case. 5 acres out of 25. Paul Plante sent letter to planning board stating that all design information should be reviewed. Planning board stated they would except statement from P.E. that lot is buildable. Existing County regulations allow fill systems on existing lots, in subdivisions fill must be in place prior to final approval. N.Y.S. Health Dept. is in the process of reviewing Blue Book. Attorney Tomaselli had no problems with the limited scope Eastern submitted on the retainer that wasoffered.

Traverse Open - Paul Hite Working on it.

Seminar - Jerry O'Conner is committee chair, many ideas to be discussed.

Night at Races - Try to set up for June.

Legal Action Fund - Money to be solicited from members for use as needed. Motion by Bill Nettleton that the legal action fund be a voluntary contribution and a separate account be set up, second by Bill Schraa: carried.

Ethical Practice Committee on State level recomended that all local ethical practice committees run correspondence through state committee.

Motion by Neil Nucci that all committee correspondence sent out should have copy sent to President, second by Mike Cirillo: carried.

Program - Dick Bovee from Clough Harbour will speak about the Thruway Bridge collapse.

Convention - Bill Schraa has numbers from last 2 conventions.

New Business:

Rensselaer County Development Council - made up of realtors, builders, investment people and the Chamber of Commerce. Rod Michael and Chris Momrow on steering committee. Chris will be attending meeting Friday, April 15. Scheduled is a discussion about Current Health Dept. policies. Council requests a leter of support from Eastern. Motion by Steve Dickson that a letter by sent to County Executive John Buono stating Eastern's support for the Rensselaer County Development Council, second by Bob Bartlett: carried.

Motion by Bill Schraa that Chris Momrow be appointed liaison to the Rensselaer County Development Council, second by Kevin McGrath: carried.
