President's Report:

NYSAPLS Concerns -

The November meeting of the NYSAPLS Board of Directors was held November 15-16, 1991 at Kutsher's Country Club. At that meeting a resolution prepared by Mid-Hudson Land Surveyors Association relative to title inspections and updating of surveys by title companies was presented. After much discussion, revisions and additions the resolution was passed.

Under Education Law 7209, if an item bearing the seal of an engineer or land surveyor is altered, the altering engineer or land surveyor shall affix to the item his seal and the notation "altered by" followed by his signature, the date of alteration and a specific description of the alteration. The terms such as "inspected" and "brought-to-date" are not in compliance with the law.
