The Secretary's Report was corrected as follows: ENYSLS's share of the value of the conference related goods is \$1700.

Bob Bartlett made a motion that the minutes be approved as corrected, and seconded by Brian Magee, passed.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Mike Cirillo.

President Lucarelli presented the president's report.

NYSAPLS

The 33rd Annual Conference was held 14-17 January at Kutcher's near Monticello, N.Y. It was generally a success. Attendance was down about 10% over last year. Over 400 had registered for the technical program.

The 34th Annual Conference will be held at the Holiday Inn-Conference Center, Rochester, N.Y. and will be hosted by Genesee Valley.

An Ad-Hoc Committee on NYS EDM Calibration Baselines is preparing a book to be published in early 1992. It will contain descriptions of official and unofficial baselines throughout NYS.

1991 membership was down approximately 3.5%. This is not considered bad, after considering the economic conditions. Total membership at the end of 1991 is 1,285.

The Legislative Committee is working on the following bills to be introduced into the 1992 Legislative Session:

- 1) addressing the use of survey affidavits by title companies
- 2) an expanded scope of practice for land surveyors
- 3) a bill to formally recognize and accept the 1983 NAD

The Public Relations Committee has published a pamphlet entitled "Choosing Land Surveying as Your Profession". Copies are available from the central office.

NYS will be starting a new format for the Land Surveying exam, beginning in October 1992, as follows:

- 1) Parts 1 & 2 will still be 4 hours each, 8 hours total, but only 1 grade will be issued for the combined score.
- 2) Part 3 will be 6 hours and compose combined Colonial and Sectionalized Land systems for 1 grade
- 3) Part 4 will be 2 hours and New York State specific, for 1 grade. NYSAPLS has combined two committees dealing with title companies. The Sellers' Affidavit Committee and the Interrelations with NYSLTA Committee are merged and will be chaired by Joe Berger of Mid-Hudson.

ENYSLS

The Great American Home Show was held 7-9 February at the Empire State Plaza. A booth at the Knickerbocker Arena was sponsored by ENYSLS. It was generally a success.

Engineers' Week is 19-21 February at the Empire State Plaza. NYSAPLS is sponsoring a booth to be manned by members of ENYSLS. Plans are proceeding. The emphasis will be on surveying as it relates to engineering projects, and.

The next general meeting will be "Paul Smiths' Night". Jim Allen is progress on the coordination of the program. Jim is waiting for a commitment from PMC regarding the number of students coming down.

There was no report from the Executive Vice President.

The Vice President, Bill Nettleton, reported that our next meeting will be at the Italian-American Community Center, Washington Avenue Extension. He also reported that the board meetings may be held at the Holiday Inn, Latham, until June. Because of renovations, it is unknown if there will be a meeting room.

Bill Lucarelli reported for Jim Allen, chairman of the Scholastic Development Committee, that PSC was in need of financial assistance in order for the students to come down this year. After a brief discussion, the board decided to assist PSC if enough sponsors for the students could be lined up.

Gerry O'Connor, chairman of the Continuing Education Committee, asked for suggestions for topics for a fall seminar to be sponsored by ENYSLS. Further discussion was tabled until the March meeting.

Gerry introduced discussion regarding the possibility of ENYSLS granting some amount of reimbursement to those associate members who successfully take the ACSM Technicians Exam, which cost \$75.00 each. A discussion was held, explaining what the exams were and what purpose is served in taking them. No action was taken.

Gerry initiated discussion concerning scholarships for associate members who are attending night school, taking survey related courses, while working full time in land surveying. This issue was referred to the Scholastic Development Committee.

Bill Nettleton, chairman of the Membership Committee, reported one former member was reapplying for senior membership. He had previously resigned in writing and therefore was not liable for any additional charges. The Secretary and his predecessor were asked to review the minutes to see what if any similar action had been taken before.

Bill presented the new membership form for Sustaining Member. It was accepted as prepared. Bill was asked to revise the general membership form and bring it up to date.

Mike Cirillo reported for the Wellness Committee that cards were sent to Sal Santonastaso, whose uncle recently passed away and to Harold Behrens, who was hospitalized in early January.

TABLED/OLD BUSINESS

The recent resignation of board member Sal Santonastaso caused the question to be raised in regard to filling the vacancy. Bill Schraa, Chairman of the Constitution and Bylaws Committee reported that there are no provisions in either document to allow the President to fill a vacancy on the board. There are only provisions to replace officers. At the time these documents were prepared and throughout their several revisions, it was thought that the importance of filling a vacancy on the board was not as significant as that of an officer of the board. A vacancy on the board will not prohibit ENYSLS from functioning, whereas the vacancy of a board officer may. It is necessary for an amendment to the constitution to change this condition. In the past, vacancies on the board were filled at the next election.

Mike Cirillo, Treasurer, explained that the tax exempt status recently granted to ENYSLS, Inc. by the IRS and NYS, only applies to the requirement for ENYSLS, Inc to pay taxes and to file a tax return.

The 1991 NYSAPLS Conference Treasurer, Mike Cirillo reviewed the materiel left over from the conference that is our share of the profit. As each item was listed, its cost and "sale" price was discussed. The following will be available for sale at the next general meeting:



Gerry O'Connor initiated discussion on the N Exemption. At the 1992 Conference, Jim Delano spoke on the status of this issue. He also illustrated how we are affected by the proposed changes to the Education law and the Scope of Services. Legislation is to be introduced into the Assembly this spring.

Gerry passed around and advertisement which appeared in the Schenectady Gazette recently, offering a seminar in land development. It is apparently being run by Mr. LaBarba and intended to help the non design professional understand the development approval process. No licensed surveyor is involved in the presentation. Mr LaBarba's staff is covering the topics advertised.



Ellen Nelson reported that work was continuing along with the new banner. It should be completed in time for the next meeting.

Bill Nettleton was asked to provide an up to date membership list for the use of the board and the Wellness Committee. It is to be sorted by employer to facilitate calls.

Steve Walrath, Chairman of the Home Show Committee reported that in spite of previous discussions and reminders to the volunteers prior to the Home Show, one proprietor did hand out business self promotional material. A resolution was presented to the board by a member, through the president, that it be made clear at any future ENYSLS displays only the profession as in general be explained and promoted, not any single individual. A motion by Bill Nettleton, seconded by Bill Schraa to table this resolution passed.

A brief discussion concerning next year's participation and operation of a booth was held.

NEW BUSINESS

Committee membership was discussed. All committees are initially functioning at the whim of its chairman or the behest of the President. When each member applied for membership, he presumably completed that portion of the application regarding his interests and where he might like to participate in ENYSLS. Apparantly that information is filed away, and only if a committee chairman wants help is there any direct membership participation.

A discussion of future social activities was held. The members will be asked for suggestions.

Tom Nesbitt presented for review a survey affidavit that he encountered in a new title report. The seller was being required to sign it in spite of the existence of a recent survey certified to the title company in question. This is evidently not an uncommon situation.. Bill Lucarelli forwarded a copy to NYSAPLS and Joe Berger.

Bill Lucarelli announced that he was having Mike Davis continue with the Goals Committee set up by Mike Cirillo last year. This committee's charge is to develop a program to try to increase both membership and member attendance.

A motion to adjourn was made by Bill Nettleton, seconded by Steve Walrath and passed at 10:02 pm.
