President Winters called the meeting to order at 5:40 pm

Secretary's Report: Dwayne Cooper

 The August 2019 BOD meeting minutes were presented to and reviewed by the BOD. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Randy Paquin, seconded by Jim Vianna. The motion was passed and the minutes accepted.

- Jim reported that the Minimum Technical Standards draft has been completed. It is going to be
 presented to NYSAPLS at the September Executive Board Meeting. Upon review by NYSAPLS,
 it will be distributed to the Regions for their review and comments. Comments by individual
 members should be made to their Regions NYSAPLS representative, who will compile a list of
 comments to submit to NYSAPLS for review and consideration. After comments have been
 reviewed, the MTS Committee will make revisions, as necessary, and submit a final report to
 NYSAPLS.

New Business:

- Location for November 14 Annual meeting to be determined.
- Jim reported that he attended the Annual Vermont Conference. While there, he attended an 8
 hour course on stone walls. He reported that it was very interesting and informative, providing
 attendees a history of stone walls ranging from their geology, how to age them and how to build
 and restore them.
- At the end of the year there will be 3 Regular and 1 Associate member positions open on the BOD. Anyone interested in running should submit a short biography to the President or Secretary, which will be mailed out to the membership for a vote.

- Jason Peterson's inquiry to NYSOP about proposed contours being allowed by LS in 1997. What
 can be done about exemptions and practicing without an exemption. He is currently waiting to
 hear from NYSOP with their response and guidance on what can be done. Jim suggested that
 Jason should prepare a report containing a summary of the situation, a timeline and copies of all
 pertinent documents which he should submit to NYSAPLS as well. Kaleb offered to submit the
 report at the next NYSAPLS Executive Board Meeting for Jason.
